Candidates will also be required to bring 10 copies of their proposal at the time of interview. It is mandatory to bring the same hall ticket/admit card used for the entrance test along with the Registration Form, valid photo-identity proof (Aadhar card/ Driving license/ PAN card/Voter identity card/Passport/College identity card) and necessary documentation at the time of interview.

At the time of interview, the candidates will be required to discuss their research area through a brief oral presentation before a duly constituted committee. The interview shall also consider the following aspects:

- a. The candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research
- b. The research work can be suitably undertaken at the University
- c. The proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge

It is advisable that the candidates inform the selection committee at the time of interview if they have consulted any member of the faculty regarding supervision.

The final selection for admission to PhD in English will be based on marks obtained at the interview. Selection of the candidates for admission to the PhD Programme in English shall depend upon availability of seats and any requirements notified by the University.

Kindly note TA/DA for appearing at the interview will not be paid to any candidate.
